Hi,

Close to two weeks have passed since I shared with you PRs and commits of most recent work you assigned to me - you had not followed up on those, neither have you assigned new projects / tasks on existing projects to me.

As per request you made numerous times on how to proceed in such situations, I started charging you for my idle time - billed under "DataInMotion Internal"; this week at minimum of 4 hours daily for each working day; this will be charged at minimum 32 hours weekly starting this coming week, as that is my average when working on projects for you (i.e. 32 hours / week).

So far, I was reluctant to do so, and always sought items I could deliver as compensation for time spent, but I need your feedback / input to do so, and you were not available to follow up for close to two weeks already.

As a reminder: our current contract, singed on July 21st 2023, is valid for one year. I've delivered all that you asked me to deliver on each project you assigned to me, provided that was within my responsibilities and I was provided with what I need to do my work. I'd like to keep delivering for you until end of our current contract, instead of charging for idle time, but I need your input.
