2 days ago I shared latest PR: <https://github.com/kentyou/feature-launcher-spec/blob/main/160> It takes care of the "The Feature Launcher Command Line", as defined in section 160.4.2.4 of OSGI compendium specification (<https://github.com/kentyou/feature-launcher-spec/blob/main/160>); see email I sent 2 days ago to Tim and yourself for more details, including screenshot.

Work for 4th week (10.05 - 10.11) is now delivered. Therefore, I am attaching invoice and time sheet for this period. Since I am sending invoice only now, its due date is adjusted accordingly.

Hi Levant,

I sent you a simplified version, considering unit of work is 1 day (i.e. daily rate mentioned in the contract).

I am using "Toggl" (<https://toggl.com/>) for time-tracking purposes, but I can only export PDFs from that - so Excel I sent you was created manually by me based on hours tracked in "Toggl" during that time period, presented in a simplified version.

Attached is also PDF version of report I can export from "Toggl" directly, where these 4-hour blocks are depicted on a day to day basis. As mentioned, I have other things going on (some business related, some not), therefore you see multiple 4-hour blocks instead of 4 days x 8 hours, but all these add up to 32 hours, which is 4 daily rates.

Please let me know if you prefer just the "Toggl" generated PDF instead of Excel created by me manually or if you have any other questions.

Hi Levant,

Since I already started work, I wanted to clarify regarding the following and get these out of the way:

1) Regarding **time logging** - do you have any preference of tool for this? If not, can e.g. Toggl (<https://toggl.com/>) be used? If you have an existing organizational account, you'd have to invite me so I can connect, otherwise I can provide exported time sheets in XLSX / PDF format, as you prefer.

2) Regarding **sync calls** - in addition to written update (and commits, of course) we discussed those would take place once per week, but I need to plan ahead and also know your preference whether this should be for this project only (e.g. every Thursday, since I started on Thursday, 12.09) or part of your general weekly call devoted for this - If so, when does such call take place? To answer your question:
- the contract with Data In Motion I shared with you after our call few weeks ago (see my email from August 8th, 2024, also re-attaching to this email) specified daily rate of 360 EUR which is 45 EUR / hour - however, that was 1 year (long term) contract, executed over a year ago (June 2023);
- for one-off short-term engagements (less than 3 months), but longer than few hours work (as implementing this will take more than a day most definitely), I can offer you 450 EUR / day daily rate - that is my regular hourly rate of 75 EUR multiplied by 6 hours minus 25% discount, i.e. **56.25 EUR / hour**;
- I can offer you further discount for longer term (i.e. 3 months or longer) contracts;
Please let me know if should prepare such short term time/material contract and I will take care of what is needed to start early next week.
Also, I have not heard from Tim yet (as of 1:30 AM 5.09.2024) - hopefully he can respond today, this way I have all info needed, at least for this initial phase (scope, deadline).

Thank you very much for reaching out. I understand it was August / holiday time, hence the silence after our call several weeks ago. I'm glad I can be of help!
Few questions to start with:
a) Is it "OSG Feature Specification" (page 71 of <https://www.ecflow.com/files/featurelauncher7/160.pdf>) or "160. Feature Launcher Service Specification" (page 93 of <https://www.ecflow.com/files/featurelauncher7/160.pdf>) or both ? You mention "OSG Feature Specification", then refer to "OSG Feature Launcher Service Specification", so it is not clear.
b) If this was a long term contract, billing would be monthly, per daily rate, since we do not have a long-term contract yet, billing would be weekly, per hourly rate, which is higher than long-term contract - either way, it is time & material, also, that implies a 62% form of contract - is that something you are comfortable with and should I prepare such short-term time & material contract then ?
c) The mentioned you want to start ASAP but how soon you need this does I'll need to know as I have other things going on and could devote 20-30 hours per week, depending on how soon this needs to be done.
I could start early next week, provided we can get formalities taken care of until then.
